Guest Speaker Blackie Wangerin



Blackie was a NASCAR Winston Cup racing legend from Minnesota, and he was our guest speaker in December 2022.

In his early racing career, Blackie made a name for himself racing stock cars on Minnesota tracks such as Elko Speedway.

Wangerin started his first NASCAR Winston Cup race at Atlanta in the Fall of 1977. He made at least one start every season thereafter until 1984. Blackie competed in three Daytona 500 races.

In 2022 The Living Legends of Auto Racing presented Blackie with the Tribute To The Early Days Award for his many accomplishments in auto racing.
