#### **Next Meeting – October 1**



Our next meeting is on Wednesday, October 1, at Colony Cottage Recreation Center, going green at 7 p.m.

Our guest speaker comes straight out of Miami's historic racing scene, Bill Taylor. After high school Bill went to work at a Ford dealership and during that time he went to many tracks, built a couple race cars (and their engines) and met a lot of people.

In 1985 after 11 years at the dealership, he opened his own engine shop and built power plants that were engineered for South Florida's stock car racing. Bill's engines tore up the short tracks in the '80s and '90s, powering cars to victory lane and titles, including the 1991 Street Stock Champion and the 1992 Thunder Car Champion at Hialeah Speedway.

Around 1990 it was obvious to Bill that short track racing in South Florida was changing – many tracks were closing. Bill went back to working a "real job" while continuing to operate his engine shop until 1995 – working two jobs and long hours. Bill was later recognized for his accomplishments when he was inducted into the Hialeah Speedway Hall of Fame as an engine builder.

Bill will take us into his shop, giving us a look at the high-precision machines that brought his horsepower to life – crankshaft balancers, rod honing machines, rod ovens, and more. And yes, he's bringing pictures!

Don't miss this chance to hear first-hand stories from one of South Florida's short track legends. If you love Florida racing history and horsepower, this is a meeting you won't want to miss!


